# Christmas meals, gifts and accommodation support

#### Christmas & winter meals

With your support, we made Christmas a little brighter for people experiencing homelessness.

- Every Christmas Eve and Christmas Day, Social Bite coffee shops across Scotland open their doors to provide a free Christmas dinner with all the trimmings and a thoughtful gift, alongside warm, welcoming company. These moments offer more than a meal—they create space for connection, support, and a step toward a brighter future. We served
  701 Christmas dinners in our coffee shops and provided over 83,000 free meals during the festive period and beyond in our Social Bite coffee shops.
- We spread kindness across the UK through our partnership with 20 grassroots organisations, reaching communities through projects in over 190 towns and cities—funding over 150,000 meals nationwide for people in need.
- We delivered 10,000+ Christmas meals we prepared through charity partners in Scotland and London.







#### **Christmas gifts**

We ask charities to provide a wish list of items that people experiencing homelessness and poverty need and value over the Christmas period, with dignity and lived experience being at the heart of the campaign.

Supporters and members of the public are then invited to donate gifts and essential items from the wish list at our Trees of Kindness in the run-up to Christmas.

In 2024, we distributed over **72,000** gifts and essential items to people in need throughout Scotland and across London. We did this through our own services and through our network of **80** charity partners and grassroots community projects. These organisations were chosen because they align with Social Bite's mission and values and work to support people experiencing homelessness and poverty.

## Accommodation & support

One of the objectives of the Festival of Kindness, alongside distributing meals and gifts, is to provide shelter and support for people in need over the winter months.

Since 2021, we have provided funding to charities in Scotland and London for emergency accommodation, supported accommodation, and support for people experiencing homelessness over the winter period.

This winter, Social Bite funded over **850** emergency bed nights for people in Scotland and London.

Each of the charities embodies our mission, vision and values and is responding to the homelessness crisis within their own community.
